Annual State of Public Education Report (SY2014-SY2015); Department of Education; Annually. This report is presented in compliance to Guam Public Law 26-26 and contains information on student demographics, districtwide assessment results, special education alternate assessment, graduation, dropout rates, including progress toward achieving the education benchmarks established by the Guam Board of Education. report also contains demographic characteristics of staff, budget and expenditure information, and examples of exemplar programs and other innovation that show improved student learning. Listing of schools and accomplishments are included. The 2014-2015 report presents the results of the two summative assessment administered for the first time in 2015 including ACT Aspire and the locallydeveloped Guam Standards-based Assessment tests. The results of the tests will assist education officials to effectively manage its programs and resource to better address the needs of the students.
